

MARCH 5, 2007---THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE CASCADE TOWNSHIP BOARD WAS HELD AT THE CALVARY EVANGELICAL FREE CHURCH MEETING ROOM AT 6:00PM. PRESENT WERE, SUPERVISORS, ARLEN HEATHMAN, HAROLD ATKINSON AND CHAIRMAN LENNY LAURES AND CLERK\TREASURER JOE VROMAN.

THE MINUTES FROM THE FEBRUARY 5TH MEETING WERE READ BY VROMAN, AND WERE APPROVED ON A MOTION BY HEATHMAN, SECONDED BY ATKINSON, ALL VOTED IN FAVOR.

THE MINUTES FROM THE FEBRUARY 10TH BUDGET MEETING WERE READ BY VROMAN, AND WERE APPROVED ON A MOTION BY ATKINSON, SECONDED BY HEATHMAN, ALL VOTED IN FAVOR.

SUPERVISOR HEATHMAN MADE A MOTION TO PAY THE JOINT POWERS BILL OF \$14,887.99 FOR THE PAST MONTH, SECONDED BY ATKINSON, ALL VOTED IN FAVOR.

A MOTION TO PAY THE REMAINING BILLS WAS MADE BY ATKINSON, SECONDED BY HEATHMAN, ALL VOTED IN FAVOR TO PAY THE TOTAL BILLS OF \$17,862.89.

TREASURER JOE VROMAN GAVE THE FINANCIAL REPORT AT THE MEETING. BEGINNING BALANCE WAS \$271,362.75, WHICH INCLUDED THE FEBRUARY CHECKING INTEREST OF 875.97, INCOME SINCE THE LAST MEETING, REIMBURSEMENT FROM ROCHESTER AND HAVERHILL TOWNSHIPS FOR THEIR SHARE OF THE ATTORNEY FEE FOR THE SHERIFF CONTRACT, \$260.00 EACH, AND THE 2007 TOWN ROAD GAS TAX OF \$19,330.41, FOR A TOTAL INCOME SINCE LAST MEETING OF \$20,726.38. CHECKS WRITTEN TOTALED \$17,862.89, WHICH INCLUDED CASCADE'S SHARE TO JOINT POWERS BOARD, FOR AN ENDING CHECKING BALANCE OF \$253,769.76. THE MOTION TO APPROVE THE TREASURERS REPORT WAS MADE BY LAURES, SECONDED BY HEATHMAN, ALL VOTED IN FAVOR.

AT 6:15PM, DEPUTY VAL COE ATTENDED THE MEETING AND PROVIDED A COPY OF INCIDENT CALLS IN CASCADE TOWNSHIP FOR THE PAST MONTH. NO PARTICULAR ISSUES OR PROBLEMS WERE BROUGHT FORTH. MENTION WAS MADE ABOUT A DAYTIME PATROL ONCE IN A WHILE COME NICE WEATHER.

AT 7:00PM, JOHN JOHNSON, FRANK ARMSTRONG AND CEDRIC SCHUTZ APPEARED BEFORE THE BOARD TO PRESENT A REVISED LAYOUT OF THE PAT FRIEDERICKS PROERTY DEVELOPMENT AND DRIVEWAY ACCESS. AFTER DISCUSSION WITH THE PRESENTERS, THE BOARD FELT THIS NEW DESIGN HAD WORKED OUT THE PROBLEMS FROM THE DECEMBER 2006 MEETING AND THEY SHOULD TAKE THIS LAYOUT FORWARD TO THE COUNTY ENGINEER MIKE SHEEHAN FOR HIS REVIEW, THEN ON TO THE CASCADE TOWNSHIP PLANNING COMMISSION.
