

MAY 7, 2007---THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE CASCADE TOWNSHIP BOARD WAS HELD AT THE CALVARY EVANGELICAL FREE CHURCH MEETING ROOM AT 6:00PM. PRESENT WERE, SUPERVISORS, ARLEN HEATHMAN, HAROLD ATKINSON AND CHAIRMAN LENNY LAURES AND CLERK\TREASURER JOE VROMAN.

THE MINUTES FROM THE APRIL 2ND MEETING WERE READ BY VROMAN, AND WERE APPROVED ON A MOTION BY HEATHMAN, SECONDED BY ATKINSON, ALL VOTED IN FAVOR.

SUPERVISOR HEATHMAN MADE A MOTION TO PAY THE APRIL JOINT POWERS BILL OF \$35,609.23 FOR THE PAST MONTH, SECONDED BY ATKINSON, ALL VOTED IN FAVOR.

SUPERVISOR HEATHMAN MADE A MOTION TO PAY THE MAY JOINT POWERS BILL OF \$12,070.92 FOR THE PAST MONTH, SECONDED BY ATKINSON, ALL VOTED IN FAVOR.

A MOTION BY HEATHMAN TO SPEND DOWN THE J.P.B. ESCROW ACCOUNT FOR EQUIPMENT AND CORRECT THE J.P.B. FOR APRIL AND REISSUE A NEW CHECK TO J.P.B., SECONDED BY ATKINSON, ALL VOTED IN FAVOR.

A MOTION TO PAY THE REMAINING BILLS WAS MADE BY HEATHMAN WITH CORRECTED CHECK TO J.P.B., SECONDED BY ATKINSON, ALL VOTED IN FAVOR TO PAY THE TOTAL BILLS OF \$60,784.37

TREASURER JOE VROMAN GAVE THE FINANCIAL REPORT AT THE MEETING. BEGINNING BALANCE WAS \$243,493.00, WHICH INCLUDED THE APRIL CHECKING INTEREST OF \$846.64, INCOME SINCE THE LAST MEETING, NONE. CHECKS WRITTEN TOTALED \$60,784.37, WHICH INCLUDED CASCADE'S SHARE TO JOINT POWERS BOARD, FOR AN ENDING CHECKING BALANCE OF \$183,197.61. MOTION TO APPROVE THE TREASURERS REPORT WAS MADE BY HEATHMAN, SECONDED BY ATKINSON, ALL VOTED IN FAVOR.

AT 6:15PM, DEPUTY VAL COE DID ATTEND THE MEETING.

AT 7:00PM, DOUG BUTLER, SUPERVISOR FROM ROCHESTER TOWNSHIP, PRESENTED AN UPDATE ON THE JOINT POWERS BOARD DRUG POLICY. SEVERAL ALTERNATIVES WERE GIVEN ON THE COST OF DRUG SCREENING PER EMPLOYEE. AFTER MUCH DISCUSSION ON THE ISSUE, SUPERVISOR ATKINSON MADE A MOTION TO ADOPT THE INTERIUM DRUG AND ALCOHOL POLICY FOR CASCADE TOWNSHIP AS PART OF THE JOINT POWERS BOARD UNTIL THE PERMANENT POLICY IS ACCEPTED. THIS WAS SECONDED BY HEATHMAN, ALL VOTED IN FAVOR.
