

CASCADE TOWNSHIP

OLMSTED COUNTY – MINNESOTA BOARD MINUTES

SEPTEMBER 7, 2010

Members present were: Chairman Lenny Laures, Supervisor Arlen Heathman, Supervisor Harold Atkinson and Clerk\Treasurer Joe Vroman.

Call to order at 6:00 pm at The Calvary Evangelical Free Church Meeting Room. All in attendance recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Attendees present: Deputy Val Coe, and 6 township residents.

Sheriff Deputy's Report:

Deputy Val Coe updated the Board on her patrol activities. She noted that the number of calls for service is not available due to a new computer system for law enforcement.

Township Board Continuing Business.

- A motion by Atkinson to approve the minutes from the August 2nd, 4th, 5th and September 1st meeting, seconded by Heathman, motion approved.
- Supervisor Atkinson made a motion to pay the August Joint Powers bill of \$14,422.59, seconded by Heathman, motion approved.
- A motion to pay the remaining Cascade bills was made by Heathman, seconded by Atkinson, all voted in favor to pay the total bills of \$27,933.23, motion approved.
- Treasurer Vroman gave the financial report at the meeting. The checkbook balance at the end of the August 2nd, 2010 meeting was \$438,948.42. Added to that total were the deposit in August, checking interest of \$76.11, Checks written at this meeting totaled \$27,933.73 for an ending checking balance on September 7th, 2010 of \$411,090.80. Motion to approve the treasurers report was made by Heathman, seconded by Atkinson, motion passed.

Township Board New Business

At 7:05PM, Adam DeCook from the Salley Hill Development requested clarification of requirements for the river access in the Salley Hill Development from the Board. He requested a list of what the requirements are for the river access. The Board stated that if the Staff report conditions are met, then the Board has no other requirements. The Board will request a meeting with Olmsted County Planning and Zoning to review the official county requirements for the river access.

At 8:00pm, Tom Olney from Olmsted County Property Records came before the Board to present information on budgets, market value credits, etc. Also explained the State of Minnesota market value credit reductions and how this affects the annual budget for the Township.

A motion by Heathman to rebid the proposed new Town Hall with updates to bid documents and have the new bid information sent out within two weeks. This was seconded by Atkinson, motion passed.

On the reappointment of a Planning Commission member whose term is up in September, a motion by Atkinson to reappoint Kevin Lenz to another 4 year term. This was seconded by Heathman, motion passed.
