OLMSTED COUNTY – MINNESOTA BOARD MINUTES

APRIL 4, 2011

Call to order at 6:00 pm at the Calvary Evangelical Free Church Meeting Room. All in attendance recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Members present were: Chairman Lenny Laures, Supervisor Arlen Heathman, Supervisor Harold Atkinson and Clerk\Treasurer Joe Vroman.

Attendees present: Deputy Val Coe, Mike Brown, Deputy Mike Bromberg

A motion by Atkinson to nominate Lenny Laures as Chairman of the Cascade Town Board until the next annual meeting in 2012, this was seconded by Heathman. Motion approved.

Township Board New Business

At 6:00PM, Deputy Mike Bromberg from the office of Emergency Operations, updated the Board on the activities of the E.O.C. and what role the Township can participate in if and when there an emergency in the County involving the Township.

Sheriff Deputy's Report:

Deputy Val Coe updated the Board on her patrol activities. There were 34 calls for service. She also updated the Board on various dog problems.

Township Board Continuing Business.

- A motion by Heathman to dispense reading of the minutes from the March 7th meeting, seconded by Atkinson, motion approved.
- Supervisor Heathman made a motion to pay the March Joint Powers bill of \$15,626.25, seconded by Atkinson, motion approved.
- A motion to pay the remaining Cascade bills was made by Atkinson, seconded by Heathman, all voted in favor to pay the total bills of \$64,071.58. Motion approved.
- Treasurer Vroman gave the financial report at the meeting. The checkbook balance at the end of the March 7th, 2011 meeting was \$441,187.38. Added to that total were the deposits in March, checking interest of \$61.53, and Olmsted County gas tax payment in of \$26,456.89.
Checks written at this meeting totaled \$64,071.58 for an ending checking balance on April 4th, 2011 of \$403,634.22. Motion to approve the treasurer's report was made by Atkinson, seconded by Heathman. Motion passed.

The Board authorized Clerk Joe Vroman to contact Keri Allhiser at KBS Construction to help with the interior color and texture coordination.

Motion to adjourn was made by Atkinson, seconded by Heathman, motion approved at 8:00pm.
