OLMSTED COUNTY – MINNESOTA BOARD MINUTES

APRIL 26, 2011

Special meeting called to order at 9:45am at the Calvary Evangelical Free Church Meeting Room. All in attendance recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Members present were: Chairman Lenny Laures, Supervisor Arlen Heathman, Supervisor Harold Atkinson and Clerk\Treasurer Joe Vroman.

Attendees present: Russ Kelm, Mike Nigbur and Doug Nelson from Rochester Public Works.

This meeting was held at the request of Rochester Public Works to address the coordination and cooperation between Cascade Township and the City of Rochester on the 65th Street improvement from the bridge over Highway 52 west to 60th Avenue NW with the most emphasis on the first mile to 50th Avenue NW.

Several ideas and options were discussed about the sharing of expenses for this project. The road is approximately 70% Township and 30% City with only a handful of Township residents living on this stretch of roadway.

This subject will again be discussed at the next regular Township meeting on Monday May 2, 2011 at 7:00pm. At that time, City of Rochester engineer Richard Freese and some of the City Public Works people will attend the meeting to see if an agreement can be settled upon for the above Street improvement.

Motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Atkinson, seconded by Heathman, motion approved at 10:30am.
