DECEMBER 5, 2011

Call to order at 6:00 pm at the new Cascade Town Hall Meeting Room in the new hall. All in attendance recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Members present were: Chairman Lenny Laures, Supervisor Arlen Heathman, Supervisor Harold Atkinson, and Clerk\Treasurer Joe Vroman.

Township Board Continuing Business.

- A motion by Heathman to dispense reading the minutes from the November 7th meeting, seconded by Atkinson, motion approved.
- Supervisor Heathman made a motion to pay the November Joint Powers bill of \$36,328.62, seconded by Atkinson, motion approved.
- A motion by Atkinson to pay the remaining Cascade bills, seconded by Heathman, all voted in favor to pay the total bills of \$136,802.84. Motion approved.

Treasurer Vroman gave the financial report at the meeting:

The checkbook balance at the end of the November 7, 2011 meeting was \$191,126.57

Added to that total was the deposit in November, checking interest of \$18.94

Bank checking statement on November 30, 2011 was \$191,145.51

Checks written at this meeting totaled \$136,802.84

Ending checkbook balance on November 7, 2011 was \$54,342.67

Motion to approve the treasurer's report was made by Laures, seconded by Atkinson, motion approved.

Sheriff Deputy's Report:

Deputy Val Coe updated the Board on her patrol activities. There were 58 calls for service since last Township meeting.

Township Board New Business

In Board discussion, it was decided to get a refrigerator and two different sized coffee makers for the Town Hall.

Also, the Olmsted County Township Officers Association is celebrating 50 years of organization with an open house invitation on Sunday January 15, 2012 at the Cascade Township hall.
