OLMSTED COUNTY – MINNESOTA BOARD MINUTES

JULY 16, 2011

Call to order at 8:00 am at the New Cascade Town Hall Meeting Room. This meeting is a continuation of the recessed regular meeting from July 11, 2011.

Members present were: Chairman Lenny Laures, Supervisor Arlen Heathman, Supervisor Harold Atkinson, and Clerk\Treasurer Joe Vroman.

Township Board Continuing Business.

This meeting continued the discussion on the Cameron Drive proposal from GGG Inc. The feasibility study is for the proposed improvements to the subsurface drainage and surfacing of Cameron Drive NW. GGG Inc. will provide the civil engineering services necessary to complete a feasibility study for roadway improvements.

After some discussion about this proposal, a motion by Atkinson to accept the bid from GGG, seconded by Heathman, motion passed.

The concrete sidewalk around the front and side of the new town hall was discussed. The location of the sidewalk and the handicapped parking area was reviewed. It was determined that 3 bids would be requested for cost and how soon the job could be completed. Chairman Laures will make the decision as to which vendor to select.

An American flag and a Minnesota flag for the New Town Hall was discussed. Clerk Joe Vroman had a cost estimate flyer from Herold Flags in Rochester. After some discussion, a motion by Heathman to order the American and Minnesota Flags at the offered package price. This was seconded by Atkinson, motion approved.

Then discussed was the August 1st, 2011 regular meeting and having an open house at the New Town Hall for all the Township residents and invited guests. A post card will be created and sent to all residents and guests inviting them to attend starting at 1:00PM. Refreshments will be served.

This card will also act as the official notification to the residents of the change in their polling place to the New Cascade Town Hall, 2025 75th Street NE, Rochester for all future Township, County, State and National elections.

Meeting adjourned at 10:00 AM on a motion by Heathman, seconded by Atkinson, motion approved.
